

Minutes of Meeting **Wednesday, November 17, 1999**



The Board of School Trustees of the North Knox School Corporation conducted its regular meeting at the Administration Building which is located on Highway 159, Bicknell, Indiana, on Wednesday, November 17, 1999, at 7:30 p.m. The following members of the board were present:

Recognition of Junior High Spell Bowl Team and Media Class - Mr. Perry introduced Miss Jones and Ms. Clubbs as sponsors and the team members of the Junior High Spell Bowl. Mr. Perry also introduced Mrs. Long and Mrs. Hoke as sponsors and the team members of the Junior High Media Class.

Approval of Minutes of October 19, 1999 Board Meeting - Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Ringo and a motion of Mr. Held, seconded by Mr. Hall, the board voted and the motion carried to approve the minutes of the October 19, 1999, board meeting.

Financial Statement - Mr. Sargent read the financial statement for the month of October.

Approval of Claims and Authorization for Payment - Payroll Numbers 5 & 6 and Claim Numbers 484-628. Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Ringo and a motion of Mrs. Villwock, seconded by Mr. Byrer, the Board voted and the motion carried to approve and authorize payment of payroll numbers 5 and 6 and claim numbers 484-628.

Request for Authorization to Pay Kerlin Bus Sales for New Bus - Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Ringo and a motion of Mr. Byrer, seconded by Mr. Held, the board voted and the motion carried to approve the payment of \$33,667.00 to Kerlin Bus Sales when our new activity bus arrives.

Discussion of Soccer Proposal - Mr. Held stated he believed some of the information presented was not factual, however he would like to see the program started at the junior high level. Mrs. Villwock stated she agreed to start the program at the junior high. Mr. Hall was also in agreement at the junior high level and thought soccer could possibly be started as a club at the high school. Mr. Byrer stated he believed implementing the soccer program would hurt the football program. Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Ringo and a motion of Mr. Held, seconded by Mr. Hall, the board voted and the motion carried with Mr. Byrer voting in the negative, to sanction soccer at the junior high level.

Request for Approval of Appointment to Knox County Public Library - Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Ringo and a motion of Mrs. Villwock, seconded by Mr. Hall, the board voted and the motion carried to appoint Beverly Stangle to the Knox County Public Library.

Resignation/Retirement of Library Aide - Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Ringo and a motion of Mrs. Villwock, seconded by Mr. Byrer, the board voted and the motion carried to accept the resignation/retirement of Evelyn Chambon as library aide at East.

Resignation/Retirement of Secretary - Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Ringo and a motion of Mr. Byrer, seconded by Mr. Held, the board voted and the motion carried to accept the resignation/retirement of Judy Russell as secretary at East.

Employment of Temporary Special Education Aide at East - Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Ringo and a motion of Mr. Hall, seconded by Mr. Held, the board voted and the motion carried to employ Sean Hobson as temporary special education aide at East.

Employment of Assistant Freshman Football Coach - Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Ringo and a motion of Mr. Held, seconded by Mr. Hall, the board voted and the motion carried to employ Ken Bilskie as Assistant Freshman Football Coach.

Employment of Elementary Girls' Basketball Coach at Central - Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Ringo and a motion of Mr. Byrer, seconded by Mr. Held, the board voted and the motion carried to employ Ramona Hammelman as Elementary Girls' Basketball Coach at Central.

Employment of Extra-Curricular Bus Driver(s) - Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Ringo and a motion of Mrs. Held, seconded by Mr. Hall, the board voted and the motion carried to employ Lester and Irene Anderson as extra-curricular bus drivers.

Employment of Half-time Special Education Aide/Sub - Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Ringo and a motion of Mr. Byrer, seconded by Mr. Held, the board voted and the motion carried to employ Gayle Perkins as half-time special education aide/sub at the high school.

Employment of AV Aide - Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Ringo and a motion of Mr. Hall, seconded by Mr. Held, the board voted and the motion carried to employ Dave Cullen as AV aide at the high school.

Employment of Junior High Basketball Scorekeeper - Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Ringo and a motion of Mr. Byrer, seconded by Mr. Hall, the board voted and the motion carried to employ Matt Hill as junior high basketball scorekeeper.

Employment of Elementary Basketball Timekeeper - Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Ringo and a motion of Mr. Hall, seconded by Mrs. Villwock, the board voted and the motion carried to employ Sharon Hobson as elementary basketball timekeeper.
